Subject: Seeking cooperation for effective implementation of the Haryana State
Commission for Women Act, 2012 in the State of Haryana.

Sir/Madam,

I have recently assumed charge as Chairperson, Haryana State Commission for Women, Panchkula. The Haryana State Commission for Women has been constituted under the Haryana State Commission for Women Act, 2012 for the protection, promotion and advancement of the rights, dignity, safety and welfare of women in the State of Haryana.

The Act entrusts the Commission with important statutory functions, including examination of safeguards provided for women under the Constitution and other laws, looking into complaints relating to deprivation of women's rights, taking suo motu notice of matters affecting women, calling for information and reports from authorities and institutions, monitoring women-related schemes and programmes, and making recommendations for remedial action wherever necessary.

Universities have a vital role in shaping a safe, equal, respectful and empowering environment for young women, girl students, research scholars, women faculty members and women employees. Institutions of higher education are expected to ensure that women on campus are protected from discrimination, harassment, exploitation, violence, intimidation, cyber abuse and denial of equal opportunity.

I, therefore, request your kind cooperation and support for effective implementation of the HSCW Act in your University and affiliated institutions. In particular, it is requested that:

1. A senior officer may be designated as Nodal Officer for regular coordination with the Haryana State Commission for Women.
2. Full cooperation may be extended whenever the Commission calls for any report, information, record or action taken report in any complaint, suo motu matter or women-related issue concerning the University or its affiliated colleges.
3. A safe and gender-sensitive campus environment may be ensured for girl students, women research scholars, women faculty members, women employees and women visitors.
4. Effective grievance redressal mechanisms may be maintained for complaints relating to sexual harassment, discrimination, stalking, cyber harassment, hostel safety, workplace dignity, victimisation or any other issue affecting women.
5. Internal committees and institutional mechanisms relating to women's safety and dignity may be made functional, accessible, confidential and responsive.
6. Women students and employees may be informed about available complaint mechanisms, helpline numbers, legal remedies, counselling facilities and support services.

7. Awareness programmes may be organised in coordination with the Commission on women's rights, gender equality, campus safety, cyber safety, prevention of sexual harassment, dignity at workplace, mental health, legal remedies and constitutional values.
8. Special attention may be given to women living in hostels, women from rural backgrounds, women with disabilities, economically weaker women, women facing harassment, and students or employees requiring counselling or protection.
9. In cases involving serious harassment, threat, violence, cyber abuse, stalking, sexual misconduct or any criminal offence, immediate lawful action may be taken in coordination with police and other competent authorities.
10. Confidentiality and dignity of the aggrieved woman may be maintained in all sensitive matters.
11. Data relating to women's safety initiatives, complaints received, action taken, awareness programmes and institutional safeguards may be shared with the Commission whenever required.
12. Compliance reports on recommendations made by the Commission may be submitted promptly and monitored at the University level.

The Commission proposes to strengthen coordination with Universities in Haryana so that higher educational institutions may become safe, inclusive, dignified and empowering spaces for women. Your cooperation will greatly assist the Commission in discharging its statutory duties and in furthering the cause of women's safety, equality and empowerment in the State.

You are requested to kindly communicate the name, designation, mobile number and email ID of the nominated Nodal Officer to this Commission at the earliest.

I look forward to your active cooperation and support in creating safer and more gender-sensitive educational institutions across Haryana.
