**Criteria for preparing merit list:**

1. The admissions will be made on the basis of Academic Merit.
2. The admissions in M.B.A. 5 Year Integrated programme will be made on the basis of Academic Merit, Group Discussion (GD), and Personal Interview (PI).
3. While preparing the merit list, marks in fractions will not be rounded off.
4. The Merit list shall be prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination + weightage of 05 marks for NSS merit certificate. The candidate having a higher percentage of marks to be ranked higher.
5. Where CGPA (Grades) is given, students will require to convert it into actual marks by using the formula applicable thereon. The admission committee will verify these converted marks.

6. In case, in any examination CGPA is given, then the candidate will have to provide the conversion formula to compute % marks from CGPA (Document supporting the conversion formula from the concerned university/board should be uploaded). In absence of a conversion formula, by default, the CGPA shall be multiplied by 9. In case CGPA as well as marks obtained, both are provided then CGPA shall be considered to compute percentage marks.
7. If two or more candidates(s) secured equal marks in the merit list, then based on the total percentage of marks obtained in Class 12 or equivalent (NOT based on BEST FIVE), the candidates having a higher percentage of marks to be ranked higher.
8. If the total percentage of marks obtained in Class 12<sup>th</sup> does not break the tie, then based on the total percentage of marks obtained in Class 10<sup>th</sup>, the candidates having a higher percentage of marks to be ranked higher.
9. If the total percentage of marks obtained in Class 10<sup>th</sup> does not break the tie, based on Date of Birth, the candidate senior/older in age to be ranked higher.
