3) The issue of equitable access to quality coaching for UPSC and other premier civil services examinations was discussed, particularly for students from less privileged backgrounds. It was decided that all Universities in Haryana (both State and Central) shall be requested, through the Department of Higher Education, to provide coaching for UPSC examinations to their students free of cost or on minimal fees. Minutes of the Meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana on 01.04.2026 at 11:30 am in CM Committee Room, Haryana Civil Secretariat to review the functioning of the Department of Future (DoF) and related long-term initiatives for the State.

A review meeting of the Department of Future (Bhavisya Vibhaag) was held under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana on 01.04.2026 at 11:30 am to consider the ongoing and proposed initiatives of the State Government related to long-term planning, infrastructure rationalisation, human capital development, and institutional strengthening. The meeting also focused on aligning departmental plans and cross-cutting initiatives with Mission Haryana 2047 and the broader objectives of long-term foresight, innovation-led governance, and inclusive growth as presented by the Department of Future.

The list of officers who attended the meeting is placed at Annexure-1.

After detailed deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

- 1) The meeting discussed the need for a structured, high-level mechanism to periodically review the progress of the Haryana Vision 2047 document and to evaluate research proposals received from universities that are aligned with long-term development priorities of the State. It was decided that a Committee shall be constituted under the Chairpersonship of the Chief Secretary to (a) review and monitor the progress on implementation of the Haryana Vision 2047 roadmap, and (b) examine and provide guidance on research proposals from universities, especially those channelled through the Department of Future and linked to State development strategies.
Action by: DG, SIJFM

- 2) In order to strengthen technical and analytical backing for long-term policy and planning work, it was decided that the Department of Future shall initiate and finalise a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with NIT Kurukshetra. The MoU shall focus on identification of priority sectors and thematic areas for the State, medium- to long-term planning support, and collaborative research and advisory work for the State Government, leveraging the academic and research strengths of NIT Kurukshetra.
Action by: Director, Department of Future

- 3) The issue of equitable access to quality coaching for UPSC and other premier civil services examinations was discussed, particularly for students from less privileged backgrounds. It was decided that all Universities in Haryana (both State and Central) shall be requested, through the Department of Higher Education, to provide coaching for UPSC examinations to their students free of cost or on minimal fees. The coaching may be organised through existing academic resources, dedicated coaching cells, or in partnership with reputed institutions, with a view to significantly broadening the pool of candidates from Haryana appearing in such examinations.
Action by: ACS, Higher Education Department

- 4) It was decided that a capacity building workshop for all Administrative Secretaries shall be organised in collaboration with NITI Aayog in the coming months, to deliberate on future-ready governance, Mission Haryana 2047 and Viksit Bharat @2047 alignment, and sectoral transformation strategies. The Department of Future shall coordinate with NITI Aayog and SJIFM/HSIIDC for the design and content of the workshop, and the expenditure on the workshop shall be borne by HSIIDC.

Action by: Director, Department of Future; MD, HSIIDC

- 5) To establish a consistent interface between the State Government and universities on long-term planning and research agendas, it was decided that each University (Central and State) in Haryana shall be requested to nominate one official as Nodal Officer for working on long-term planning issues of the State. These Nodal Officers shall liaise with the Department of Future and the Department of Higher Education to identify research themes, support Horizon 2047 strategies, and contribute to preparation and review of long-term policy inputs.

Action by: ACS, Higher Education Department

- 6) It was observed that multiple electricity poles exist on individual street lines across the State, resulting in visual clutter as well as redundancy in the power distribution network. The Hon'ble Chief Minister directed that the Energy Department shall prepare a comprehensive 5-year plan for rationalisation and shifting of electricity poles from streets, aiming to reduce avoidable redundancy, improve street aesthetics, and optimise use of physical infrastructure. The plan shall also specify modalities for re-use of redundant material and, wherever necessary, formulation of a special scheme for systematic removal of surplus poles from streets.

Action by: Energy Department

- 7) The existing approach of primarily awarding cash incentives to high-performing sportspersons was discussed, and it was emphasised that the State must also invest in identifying and nurturing new and emerging talent from an early stage. It was decided that the Sports Department shall prepare a new Sports Policy laying greater emphasis on development of sports infrastructure, provision of structured cash grants and support to emerging sportspersons, talent identification at grassroots level, and sustained capacity building, in addition to rewards for achievers. The Department shall also prepare a comparison chart of Haryana's sports promotion policy vis-à-vis the sports policies and promotion mechanisms of other leading States, highlighting best practices and gaps.
