At the very outset, Prof. S.P. Bansal, Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Academic Council.

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VICE-CHANCELLOR'S STATEMENT

You will all agree with me that the initial stages in the life of an Institution are fraught with difficulties and challenges, as it requires paving way for the fruitful future and established systems. It also requires lots of innovative steps to be taken. It has been my proud privilege to be a part of this phase when things need to be streamlined and systems be carried to a mature level. In this process of shaping up the University, we have a long list of achievements, among which a few need special focus.

We have inaugurated International Centre for foreign languages. It will enable the students of IGU to learn three foreign languages viz. Italian, Spanish and German for which the teachers from Italy will provide on-line services. Besides this, IGU will send its students to Italy for internship.

Recently, the colleges of district Rewari and Mahendergarh are affiliated to IGU. We see it as another feather added to our cap. We are committed to provide the best to them with regard to curriculum, examinations and results.

We have got a grant of Rs. 1.12 crores for developing a fine module for e-learning. The main focus in e-learning is to prepare conversable material for various courses based on high quality curriculum.

At another front, we made a visit to the seven villages adopted by IGU with a view to gauge economic, social and educational status of these villages for the purpose of Job Fair which we organized at a huge level in the month of March, 2017.

Several new courses like M.Sc. Environmental Science and M.A. Yoga are also started from the current academic session 2017-18.

Our Incubation Centre is running fairly well. Coaching Centre and Skill Development Centre will soon take wings.

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Among our future targets, setting up the Distance Education learning Centre is at priority. We have also planned to start Correspondence Courses for needy students. Starting short-term courses is also on the anvil.
