Item No. 6 was considered and resolved that clauses "the candidates must secure at least 30% marks (5% relaxation to SC/ST candidates of Haryana only i.e. 28.5% marks) in the Entrance Test to be eligible for admission to those courses in which admission are made through entrance test.
