
Item No. 6 was considered and resolved that clauses "the candidates must secure at least 30% marks (5% relaxation to SC/ST candidates of Haryana only i.e. 28.5% marks) in the Entrance Test to be eligible for admission to those courses in which admission are made through entrance test. If seats remain vacant, the above requirement of marks can be relaxed upto 10% marks by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the Chairperson of the Department concerned.
