Proceedings of the Meeting of 'Youth Welfare Committee' for the session 2019-20 held on 3rd October, 2019 at 10:30 A.M. in the Conference Hall, Patel Bhawan, I. G. U. Meerpur

- 1. Resolved that the proceedings of the last meeting of Youth Welfare Committee held on 6th October, 2018 (Annexure-I) is confirmed.
- 2. Considered and approved a tentative Calendar of activities for session 2019-2020 (annexure II).
- 3. Considered and approved that the Youth Festival, 2019 may be organized at Zonal and Inter-Zonal levels if the participation is substantial otherwise it may be organized at university level Fest as per past practices and the recommended tentative dates for organizing Youth Festival, 2019 may be 4-5-6 Nov, 2019, 7-8-9Nov., 2019, for Inter-Zonal level.
- 4. Considered and approved the formation of Zones for Youth Festivals for the session 2019-20 as given below:
 - 1.) Rewari Zone
 - 2.) Mohindergarh Zone
- 5) Considered and approved that the Zonal and Inter Zonal Youth Festival be organized by the Youth/Students Welfare Office under the aegis of Youth Welfare Committee. However, the accounts of the amount remitted to the convener for pre-arrangements and petty purchases etc. for the Zonal and Inter- Zonal Festival be managed /Controlled by the convener and monitored by the Director Youth Welfare. However the arrangements towards seating, Shamiyana, light and sound, purchase of prizes and other petty purchases be made by sub-committee(s) constituted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for the Inter-Zonal Youth Festival. (Approved vide resolution no. 3 dated 23rd Nov.2017)
- 6. Considered and approved the 'Rule Book' containing rules and regulations for holding/organization of Zonal and Inter Zonal Youth Festival (on the pattern of AIU) of the university for the session 2019-20 with the edited version. (Annexure III)
- 7. Considered and discussed the venue and the conveners for organizing the Zonal Youth Festivals/Inter-Zonal Youth Festival for the session 2019-20 as per the willingness received in front of Committee:
- i) Rewari Zone :Principal GCW, Sector 18, Rewari

- i) Rewari Zone :Principal GCW, Sector 18, Rewari
- ii) Mahendergarh Zone: RPS Balana.
- 8. Considered and approved that the budget for Youth Festival, 2019 will be Rs. 12,00,000/.
- 9. Considered and approved that the entry fees may be at par with the MDU Rohtak i.e. Rs. 3,000/- instead of proposed fee of Rs. 2,000 per institution/Organization for session 2019-20.
- 10. Considered and approve the enhanced rates of prizes in cash/kind to be given/ awarded to the winners of Zonal Youth Festival and Inter-Zonal Youth Festival shall be under:

IGU Zonal Youth Festival

Individual/Group Item

First Position Rs. 500/-per head (instead of Rs. 400/earlier)

Second Position Rs. 450/-per head (instead of Rs. 350/earlier)

Third Position Rs. 400/-per head (instead of Rs. 300/earlier)

IGU Inter Zonal Youth Festival

Individual/Group Item

First Position Rs. 750/-per head (instead of Rs. 500/earlier)

Second Position Rs. 650/-per head (instead of Rs. 450/earlier)

Third Position Rs. 550/-per head (instead of Rs. 400/earlier)

- 11. Considered and approved that the Refreshment of Rs.60/per head per day to be to be served to the participants during rehearsals and to the Chief Guests/Guests/Teachers/members of various committees/Campers and each staff member on duty during the Youth Festivals, YLTS., Trekking Expeditions, Value based Spiritual Camps/Courses and other Functions etc. organized by the Dean Students's Welfare Office.
- 12. Considered and approved the enhanced rates of Honourium of Rs.1000/- per item, per head, per day along with actual TA and Rs 500/- per item, per head, per day, in case of additional items for the same judge, if required for the judgment during the youth festival and other function organized by DSW office session 2019-20.

13. Considered and approved that the provision of Taxi/Car facilities to the judges invited for various festivals as under:

The facilities of taxi /own car be provided to one judge as per his/her entitlement, in case he/she is only judge to travel from that station or more (two/three judges) from a route/station are invited to act as judge(s) during the Zonal/Inter Zonal Youth Festivals.

This facility will also be extended to judges who falls in a special category i. National Awardees like Padamashree, Padam Vibhushan, National/International Level and State Level etc.

- 14. Considered and approved that the enhanced rate of Rs. 700/-be paid to the accompanist, per day, per rehearsal (at least 3 hrs.) for a maximum period of 15 days for group items and Rs 750/-to be paid per accompanist, per day for stage performance (instead of 600/- and 650/-earlier approved) hired from outside for festivals organized by DSW. DA at par with the students / campers is paid in addition to the amount paid for the rehearsals and stage performance out the station. Rehearsals and stage performance will be considered section wise not item wise.
- 15. Considered and approved that the following decision taken in the earlier meetings of the Youth Welfare Committee be made applicable for the current session 2019-20:
- 1.) That there will be uniformity in the certificates to be issued to the winners under the signatures of convener of the Zonal Youth Festivals and Director Youth Welfare in respect of the Zonal Youth Festival and under the signatures of Vice-President(DSW) and Secretary (DYW) in respect of Inter Zonal Youth Festival Further, the blank certificates for Zonal Youth Festivals will be supplied to the Conveners of all the Zonal Youth Festivals by the DYW and that the prizes to the winners be arranged as per the past practice by the conveners of the host college.(Approved vide resolution no. 3 dated 23rd Nov.2017)
- 2). That the cash Prize of Rs. 11,000, Rs 5100/- along with trophy to the overall 1st and 2nd position holder of colleges of Folk Festival marked as per pattern of IZYF winners already approved vide resolution no. 5 dated 23rd Nov.2017)
- 3). That the cash award of Rs. 21000/- to a team securing 1st position in terms of overall performance in a zone which is to be distributed equally among all the students participants to the college. This award shall be in addition to the usual grant- in- aid organizing the youth festival. Overall trophy given by the Convener-Principal out the grant-in-aid. (Approved vide resolution no. 6 dated 23rd Nov.2017)
- 16. Considered and approved that the Protest Fee during Zonal/Inter Zonal Youth Festivals will be Rs. 1000/ per protest.
- 17. Considered and approved that any item or event may be dropped according to the circumstances (if found controversial)

18.Considered and approved that only best team be sent to All India Inter University (Zonal/National) Youth festival on the basis of the performance of the participants/artist in the university youth festival. Further a maximum of 15 days coaching camp/workshop be organized for the preparation of the participant/teams to participate in the youth festival of AIU.

19. Considered and approved the Cultural Stipend for the outstanding students in Cultural Activities from the current session 2019-20, i.e

Cultural Stipend of Rs 15,000/-and 11,000/- each be awarded to those students who won 1st/2nd position respectively in A.I.U.(National) Youth Festival in group/individual item

Cultural Stipend of Rs. 7,100/ and Rs. 6,100/- each be awarded to those students who won 3rd/4th position respectively in A.I.U. (National) Youth Festival in group/individual item

Cultural Stipend of Rs. 5,100/ and 4,100/- each be awarded to those students who won 1st/2nd position respectively in A.I.U. (Zonal Level) Youth Festival in group/individual item.

The team/ winner of Inter Zonal Youth Festival of the University. North Zone Inter University Youth Festival/National Youth Festival will be awarded the above cultural stipend etc. as the case may be if they participate in festival of higher categories when selected by the Dean Students' Welfare Office, failing which the cultural stipend etc. will be forfeited.

20. Considered and approved that any amendment/alteration in the rules/Items related to Youth Festivals 2019-20 will be made with the approval of the President, Youth Welfare Committee (Vice- Chancellor).

- 20. Considered and approved that any amendment/alteration in the rules/Items related to Youth Festivals 2019-20 will be made with the approval of the President, Youth Welfare Committee (Vice- Chancellor).
- 21. Considered and approved that other Activities which are not included in the Tentative Calendar of activities maybe organized as per instructions of Chancellor/State Government/Central Government/ request other Universities out of the fund of miscellaneous fund with prior approval of the President of Youth Welfare committee(Vice-Chancellor).
- 22. Considered and approved that the enhanced rates of Remuneration be paid to the Teacher, Officials and Attendants/peons, who attend the various camps and courses, organized by the Dean student's Welfare Office, excluding the journey days besides their usual TA/DA as Under:

Attendant/Peon---- Rs. 150/-(Earlier it was Rs 100 /day)

- 23. Considered and authorized the Dean Students Welfare to constitute local purchase committee to finalize the various agencies for routine needs like flowers decoration, flex/ banners, printing of festival materials and engagement of light and sound system for various programmes at university campus throughout the session.
- 24. Considered and authorized the Dean Students Welfare to finalize the various agencies conducting the adventure programmes to organize the various camps under the aegis of Students' Welfare Office on lowest rate basis.
- 25. Resolved and approved that the (as per the table item agenda placed with permission of the chair) one more event of 'Mehandi' will be added to the list of items (on the table with permission of the chair).
